



# 2014 Cuvee De L'ile

Cuvee De L'ile is one of Unsworth's smallest production wines. Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris and Auxerrois are sourced from our estate vineyard and from parcels in Glenora and North Cowichan. After tank and neutral barrel aging, the wine is lees aged in tank for a further 15 months before hand riddling and disgorgment and a further year aging before release.



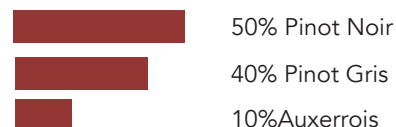
### TASTING NOTES

Straw in colour. Apples, citrus and hints of cloves followed by green apple and orange peel, adding a brightness to a dense and generous mouthfeel



### TERROIR

Clay and alluvial soils over a vast gravel base span the cool climate wine region of the Cowichan Valley. Long days during the growing seasons are moderated by proximity to the Pacific Ocean. This encourages full phenolic development while maintaining vibrancy. Our 12.5 acre vineyard is planted with six acres of Pinot Gris (6,500 vines) and Pinot Noir (2,050 vines) as well as six acres of unique island varieties. We also work very closely with a number of near-by vineyards.
