### 2019 CHARDONNAY

This is our inaugural release of this noble grape—originating from a Chardonnay block that was meticulously rehabilitated by Carsten and Kim Mildenstein—and certain to become a mainstay of the Unsworth portfolio. Aromas of lemon, yellow apple and blanch almonds on the nose lead to vibrant citrus and apple notes on the palate. Coy in its youth, this wine will continue to develop complexity with 3-5 years in the cellar.
