Pale pinkish-orange; open fragrant and very attractive, this features an engaging range of sweet-tart red fruit, creamy and intense, on a dry mid-weight frame at the sharper end of the spectrum. Lees have been used to great effect to soften and balance crunchy acids, making this both smooth and bright, and saliva-inducing. Very good length. Classy and complex, well-made rosé all around. Tasted October 2020.
