Light, leafy, and vaguely acetic-acid tinged, this Vancouver Island pinot also features old dusty, resinous wood character, cinnamon and cedar, giving it a more typically old world flavour profile. Extraction is well managed on the palate, with very fine, dusty, supple tannins, bright but not shrill acids, and solid, lingering finish. A savoury experience all in all, ready to enjoy or hold short term. Tasted October 2020.
